The Botanical Society of Bengal, established in the year 1935, is one of the oldest and most vibrant Societies in the country to cater to the botanical needs through its various activities and regular publications of the journal amongst the botanists of the country. The inaugural meeting of the Society was held at the Botanical Laboratory, C.U. on 13th December 1935. Mr. Shyamaprasad Mukherjee, M. A., B. L., Barrister at Law, N.I.L.A. Vice Chancellor presided. He said "the members of the Society should not confine their activities to only on the prosecution and publication of scientific researches but should also disseminate the knowledge of arranging popular lectures and exhibitions among the general public." He said that he knew that investigations could not be carried out without money, the University was in fact, intended to encourage such beneficial activities. He wished the Society a long and successful career of usefulness. Presently the Society is organizing the 3<sup>rd</sup> Botanical Congress for further dissemination of Botanical knowledge among the various sectors of the society.
